

The Lycoming County Custody Exchange Center is committed to providing a secure, comfortable and child-friendly place where children can continue a positive relationship with both of their parents through monitored custody exchanges. This service is free and confidential.

Hours of Operation

Mondays: 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Wednesdays: 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Fridays: 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Sundays: 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

We will be open on these select holidays:

- Christmas
- Thanksgiving
- Easter

Parents are expected to be on time for their scheduled exchanges. If you are unable to be present, please call at least 24 hours prior to your exchange.

Who Qualifies?

All participants must live in Lycoming County and have a court-ordered custody agreement.



Communication & Respect

Communication is important to all of us. We seek to provide consistent, stress free, clear and comfortable exchanges. We make every effort to create and maintain a respectful environment to ensure the safety and security of everyone at the Custody Exchange Center.

Parents and children can be expected to be treated with respect.

Safety

The program is designed so that parents have no on-site contact. You will be assigned to use one of the two entrances to the Custody Exchange Center. To ensure no contact you must park in the designated area and use the door that is assigned to you for all exchanges.

Orientation

Before services may begin, both parents must participate in orientation.

Please bring the following with you to orientation:

- Photo Identification
- Current court or custody orders, current Protection from Abuse Orders (PFA), any additional relevant paperwork

During orientation you can expect to meet Custody Exchange Center staff, tour the facility, review policies and procedures, discuss safety concerns and get answers to any of your questions.
